SUMMER SEWER LINE **REPLACEMENT PROJECTS**

The Brunswick Sewer District is committed to providing our customers with safe and reliable wastewater services. As part of that commitment, we will be replacing aging sewer lines in several locations throughout the district this summer.

These projects will involve replacing sections of sewer main and associated infrastructure. The upgrades will improve system reliability, reduce the risk of blockages and backups, and increase overall capacity.

Construction is expected to begin in Spring 2025 and be completed by Fall 2025. Work will be limited to weekdays to minimize disruptions.

During construction, residents can expect some temporary traffic delays and detours in the immediate vicinity of the work zones. We will work closely with the contractor to minimize disruptions and maintain access to properties.
