<p><b>Work relevant to environmental topics:</b></p>	<p><b>Remove CLEAN water BEFORE it enters the public sewer system.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All this water overwhelms the public sewer system.</li> <li>• To provide for efficient and EFFECTIVE wastewater treatment.</li> <li>• To provide capacity for future growth without the need for (very) expensive pump station and treatment plant construction.</li> <li>• Sump pump discharges to the public sewer is illegal by federal, state, and local law.</li> </ul>
<p>Collaboration opportunities:</p>	<p><b>If you're interested in having an efficient and effective Sewer District, with more affordable rate structure, that will provide the sustainable system capacity to meet the growth needs of the Brunswick community – then we need your help:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To identify which homes and businesses have sump pumps connected to the public sewer.</li> <li>• So we can map where in our system these are located.</li> <li>• And plan, with the help of the Town and Property Owners,</li> <li>• where the storm water system needs to be expanded or installed to accept sump pump discharges.</li> </ul>
