## *Notice of Public Meeting*

### To Review the Construction Schedule and Site Access Issues for the *Union Street Utility Improvement Project* (between Mill Street and Cedar St)

**Thursday, February 22, 2018**  
**12:30 PM at People Plus, 35 Union Street**

The Town of Brunswick will host a meeting to review the work schedule for the proposed utility and road improvements to Union Street, from Mill Street to Cedar Street. Work will start in approximately mid-March with final completion of all work planned by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Representatives of the Town, Brunswick Sewer District and Brunswick-Topsham Water District along with the Town's contractor, Crooker Construction, LLC, will be available Thursday, February 22, 2018 at 12:30 p.m. in the People Plus Meeting Room, 35 Union Street to review the work plans, the proposed schedule of reconstruction work and traffic impact. You are invited to hear what is planned and offer comments, questions and feedback.

We are hoping to get this major reconstruction work completed in a manner that will accommodate traffic and maintain convenient access to all abutting properties. However, full closure of sections of Union Street to vehicular traffic for a week or more at a time will be required to allow the replacement of all storm drain lines, sewer lines and water lines. Once the utility work is completed Union Street will be fully repaved from Mill Street to Pleasant Street. Parking on Union Street will be prohibited in work areas. Pedestrian access will be maintained but will be limited at times when utility excavation work blocks the sidewalk on one side at a time. We welcome input regarding your concerns so we can do what we can to get the work done and meet your needs.

Accommodations for this meeting will be made for persons with disabilities and auxiliary aids will be provided upon advance request.
