

NEW ONLINE PORTAL FOR BILL PAYING & ACCOUNT VIEWING


In August 2021, the Administrative Division successfully transitioned to Tyler Technologies Munis ERP as the District's comprehensive accounting software. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this migration and all associated training were conducted remotely via Zoom. While this presented unique challenges, our dedicated staff embraced the process with tenacity and perseverance. We commend their exceptional efforts in navigating this less-than-ideal transition and successfully completing this vital project.

We value our customers' feedback and have heard your requests for enhanced online account management features. In response, we are pleased to announce the availability of the following new features:

- Online Account Viewing: Conveniently access and review your account details online.
- Electronic Bill Access: Obtain copies of your individual bills or a full year's worth of bills electronically.
- Email Billing: Opt to receive your bills directly via email.
- Recurring Payments: Set up automated payments using your preferred credit/debit card.
- Payment Options: Choose from various payment methods, including online, mail, in-person, or automatic ACH payments.

How to Access the Portal:

- $1.\ Visit\ our\ website: www.brunswicksewer.org$
- 2. Click on the "Billing" dropdown menu.
- 3. Select "Online Payments."
- 4. Enter your Customer Number (from line 1 of your bill) and Account Number (from line 2).
- 5. Choose "Quick Pay" to access your latest bill directly.
- 6. For full portal features, select "Sign in or sign up" and create your account using your preferred method (Google, Apple, Microsoft, Facebook, or email).
- 7. Set up two-factor authentication (email or text) for added security.



Fees:

- Credit/Debit Card Payments: 2.95% fee on the balance due, with a minimum charge of \$2.50.
- E-check Payments: \$0.95 fee per payment.

Fee-Free Payment Options (Not Available Through the Portal):

- Mail a check: BSD, 10 Pine Tree Rd, Brunswick, ME 04011.
- Pay in person: 10 Pine Tree Road.
- ACH Payments: Automatic withdrawals from your account on the due date.

- Sewer Science: Wastewater treatment involves a fascinating mix of biology, chemistry, and engineering. It's a complex process that requires skilled professionals to ensure that wastewater is treated safely and effectively.
- Supersized Systems: The largest wastewater treatment plant in the world is in Chicago, Illinois. It can treat a staggering 1.2 billion gallons of wastewater per day!

- Credit card or by e-check online, with a fee charged. (Fee is 2.95% of transaction amount with a \$2.50 minimum. Fee for e-check \$1) Please visit our website, <u>www.brunswicksewer.org</u>, click the "Billing" dropdown menu, and select "Online Payments."
- Automatic deduction from your checking or savings account (No fee charged).
 Go to our website, select the "Billing" tab, and select "Direct Payments".
